CRITERIA

- Writers may submit one electronic application only.
- All plays submitted must be currently in development and not have been previously staged.
- Whilst Yellamundie are not initially requesting Proof of Aboriginality/Torres Strait Islander identity, please be aware that you may be requested to provide this at a later date.

DATES AND DEADLINES

Wednesday 3rd December 2014: Applications open

Wednesday 4th February 2015: Applications close

Friday 6th March 2015: Successful applicants announced

HOW TO APPLY

Download the application form and guidelines from moogahlin.com/yellamundie.html or email yellamundie@moogahlin.com to request they be sent to you. This form is most easily completed using Adobe Reader. (Click/touch to download.)

Applications must be submitted to yellamundie@moogahlin.com by 11:59pm Wednesday 4th February 2015 and include:

- The completed application form.
- Your original play script.*

* If you do not have a full script to send, you may send a theatrical scene and/or material of at least five (5) A4 pages.

ASSESSMENT

Applications will be assessed by the Yellamundie National Curatorial Team.

OUTCOMES

Successful applicants will receive free travel to & accommodation in Sydney to attend the festival.

Week 1: Scripts will be work-shopped with a director, a dramaturg and actor/s.*

Week 2: Scripts will be read to an invited industry and community audience.
